



EXHIBITOR INSURANCE INFORMATION

Please remember these guidelines for insurance purposes at *The Decorative Arts Show including The Faux Event*:

Exhibitors are reminded, however, that this is an open booth show and that the primary responsibility for the safeguarding of exhibits and equipment rests with the exhibitor. Neither *The Decorative Arts Show including The Faux Event*, the Atlantic City Convention Center, the Security Contractor, the General Services Contractor (AGS Expo Exposition Services), nor any of their officers, agents, representatives or employees assume any responsibility for such property. Because of this, exhibitors should have a rider on their insurance policies covering the transportation of merchandise from their home base to the show, the display of merchandise at the show and the transportation of merchandise back to home base.

INSURANCE & LIMITS OF LIABILITY

Exhibitors are strongly urged to insure themselves, at their own expense, against property loss or damage and against liability for personal injury.

Each exhibitor **must** make provisions for the safeguarding of their goods, materials, display and personnel at all times. General overall guards will be employed by *The Decorative Arts Show including The Faux Event* for the exposition period. However, *The Decorative Arts Show including The Faux Event* **will not be responsible for any losses incurred by the exhibitor or its employees for any reason, nor to any property or employees of exhibitors while in route to or from the show.**

Please check with your insurance company to be certain that you carry coverage for protection during your participation as an exhibitor. You are urged to insure ALL MERCHANDISE.
